Case report

- Male 53 years old. DMII. Possible overuse alcohol last time.
- Posted by approximately one day's history, unclear speech, walking difficulties.
 Submitted to the neurological department: Cerebral infraktion?
- Was submitted to the internal medicine department, after a few hours quickly falling consciousness, coma.

Lab

 Blood gas: pH 7.08. pCO2 1.44. pO2 17.0. Bic3, 1 ask -25.6. lactate 11.7. K 6.7.

- Kreatinin 90 Urine Microscopy: a lot of crystals. Calcium oxalate.
- Anion gap: (145 7) (112 + 3) = 47
- Estimated osm: 1.86 x145 + 5 3 (0 ethanol)/ 0.93 = 299

Measured osm: 350 Osmolaltgap 350-299 = 51

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
