Exchange Programs must be longer than one month. Maybe 3-6 months. I had experience in UK 1.5 month but it is not enoug I think it must be longer.

be strict on the timetable on case presentations: if someone uses up their 15mins just presenting, there shouldn't be further discussion allowed. it's important to learn how to just present the important points of a case! (and it's quite boring, if someone fails to do so!)further I would suggest doing a short evaluation of every case presentation (with regards to content and presentation skill)by the responsible senior (Prof. Lindgren did so superbly!)
